

Please check the contents of the bag.

You will find, the phone, 240 & 12v chargers and an external/emergency Antenna (pictured below).

Our most common damage is damage to the antenna. When rotating **use the base not the tip** of the antenna. The antenna should rotate firmly, if it feels loose run the following procedure with **antenna pointing down**. Depress the button on the top of the phone and push the antenna in firmly (don't force) then release the button. We check the phones before we send them, **please check the condition of the phone** and the antenna when you receive it and before you use the phone.



When charging, the phone screen will tell you it is charging and when charging is complete without having to turn the phone on. The phone should be fully charged when you receive it.

Basic operation.

While standing outside with a clear view of the sky, rotate and extend the Antenna. Press the on/off button. The phone will take a short while to find a satellite and register.

Making calls

Make sure the aerial is pointing straight up. In Australia: If calling an Aust. number dial the STD code. If you want to call outside Australia dial + (press and hold "0") then the country and area code.

Note: If you are 200km outside Australia the incoming calls will cost you \$3.00 per minute. Inside Australia incoming calls do not cost you and are charged to the caller the same rate as a normal mobile call.

SMS. (99cents out going)

Use the envelope/message key and the scroll bar to find message editor. Follow the prompts and type the message as per a normal mobile phone. You may need to hit ^ key to move to the next letter space.

Voice mail messages.

We have turned off the message bank system as you will be charged if messages are left. If you want message bank please call and I will activate it for you.

The on/off switch is bottom left

If any part of the phone is damaged please call immediately.

If you lock the phone the unlock code is HIRE (4473)

The phone number of this phone is on the tag.

Please call a mobile and check the caller ID to confirm, just in case.
